 - Complete LCHSAA entry label (Name, Class, 1 sample for each Judge)
 - Registration closes at 2:00pm
- Cooks can register only 1 meat to be judged
- Cooks will complete and place LCHSAA entry label on all containers
 - If labels are not filled out completely, your entry may be disqualified
- Cooks are to place all meat in closed Styrofoam container for judging
- Contestants will bring covered foods to the LCHSAA tent for judging
- Contest/Judging begins at 2:00pm
- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards and or certificates will be awarded
- Winners will be announced at 3:00pm by Alumni DJ
- Winners will need to report to the LCHSAA tent for awards and photos
- The cook and class that wins 1st place will be known as the class with the "Hottest Coals"
- Cook-Off Judges will keep LCHSAA Officers abreast of the process as needed to enhance the experience
- Contestants are to adhere to all suggestions and guidance given by the Cook-Off Judges and LCHSAA
- Cook-Off Judges have the authority to eliminate any registered contestants as needed
